HISTORY

On July 2, 1983, 11 women came together from across the nation to discuss the formation of a new organization to serve women construction owners and executives.

The women were all members of various construction-related groups and organizations. But the feeling among them was unanimous, that while the organizations they belonged to were valuable, none filled the need of furthering the goals of women owners and executives in construction.

OUR PURPOSE

Following that 1983 meeting, the women came together and developed the following principles:

- Promote the role of Women Business Enterprises (WBEs) in the construction industry.
- Assist women in executive management positions within the industry.
- Provide resources to enhance the professional development of every member.
- Create a legislative network to monitor and pursue legislation advantageous to our business community and the construction industry.
- Encourage professional standards and member responsibility within the industry.

THE WCOE CHARTER

On January 20, 1984, the Articles of Incorporation of WCOE, USA, a non-profit organization, were filed in the state of Washington.

Less than one month later, the new WCOE, USA Executive Board held its first meeting, where the organization's Bylaws were approved and adopted, and its officers were elected. At the Charter Meeting and Conference in October 1984, 69 women signed the WCOE, USA charter. Representatives from the White House, Department of Transportation, Department of Housing & Urban Development, Department of Energy and many successful business owners attended the program.


